to follow in his footsteps and seek immortality for themselves The elaborate tombs and burial rituals found in ancient Egypt were all built in search of this goal with the funerary practices being done to aid the spirit in its journey through the underworld Pharaohs and wealthy Nobles could afford more elaborate burials with trinkets and spells to help them in their journey but the average Egyptian could survive the underworld as well
