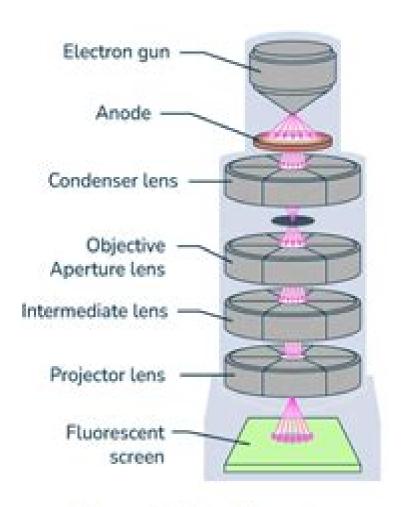
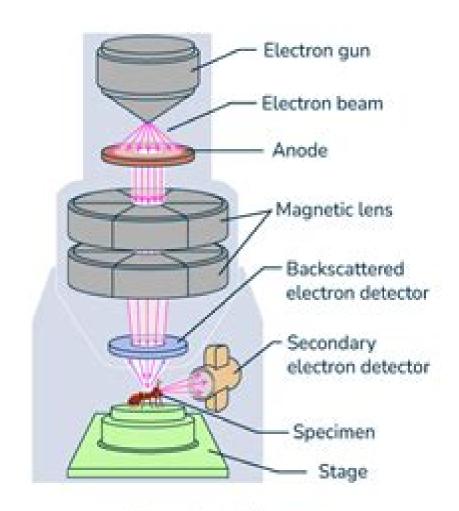


Diagram of Electron Microscope
