

charismatic leader foundered when that leader s power distanced him from his followers LeWarne followed the Family for years attending its celebrations and interviewing the faithful and the disaffected alike He tells the Family s story with both sympathy and balance describing daily life in the urban and later the rural communes and explaining the Family s deeply felt spiritual beliefs The Love Israel Family is an important chapter in the history of communal experiments in the United States


