

EARLY EVEN-TOED UNGULATES

In modern times the main grazing animals belong to the order Artiodactyla – the even-toed ungulates. They are characterized by the presence of the cloven hoof (meaning formed by the hoofs of two toes side by side). The artiodactyls evolved about the same time as the perissodactyls – the odd-toed ungulates – but were later in developing and did not really spread until the perissodactyls declined.

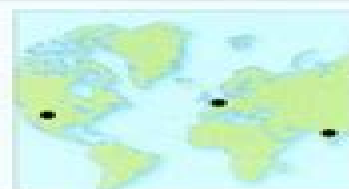
Diacodexis

The earliest artiodactyls would have been almost indistinguishable from the earliest perissodactyls in general appearance and lifestyle, but they had all five toes on each foot. These reduced to two toes as the group evolved. One of the earliest families was the Dichobunidae, which looked more like rabbits than ungulates.



Alight, it seems so specialized that it is doubtful if Diacodexis itself was an ancestor of any of the rest of the artiodactyl group.

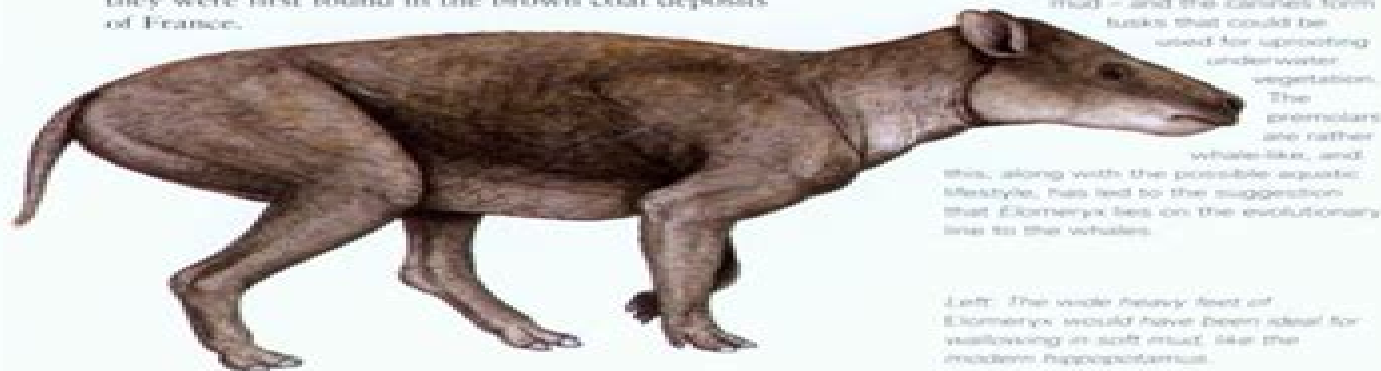
Features: With the general build of a modern muntjac deer, Diacodexis has the features of an animal that lived by scampering through undergrowth. The articulation of the legs shows that it was able to run, but not as efficiently as others of the group. The teeth are low and have rounded cusps – an indication that it may have been omnivorous.

Elomeryx

The anthracotheres were a family of early ungulates that may have given rise to the hippopotamus and its relatives. Certainly they seem to have had a hippopotamus-like semi-aquatic lifestyle. Their name means "coal mammals" – a reference to the fact that they were first found in the brown coal deposits of France.



Features: Elomeryx has a long body and short stumpy legs. The broad feet have five toes on the front and four on the back. The head is long and rather horse-like. The incisors are spoon-shaped – ideal for digging in mud – and the canines form tusks that could be used for uprooting underwater vegetation. The premolars are rather whale-like, and this, along with the possible aquatic lifestyle, has led to the suggestion that Elomeryx lies on the evolutionary line to the whales.
