the gods constituted a central part of medieval Japanese religion and that the latter cannot be reduced to a simplistic confrontation parallelism or complementarity between some monolithic teachings known as Buddhism and Shinto Once these reductionist labels and categories are discarded a new and fascinating religious landscape begins to unfold
