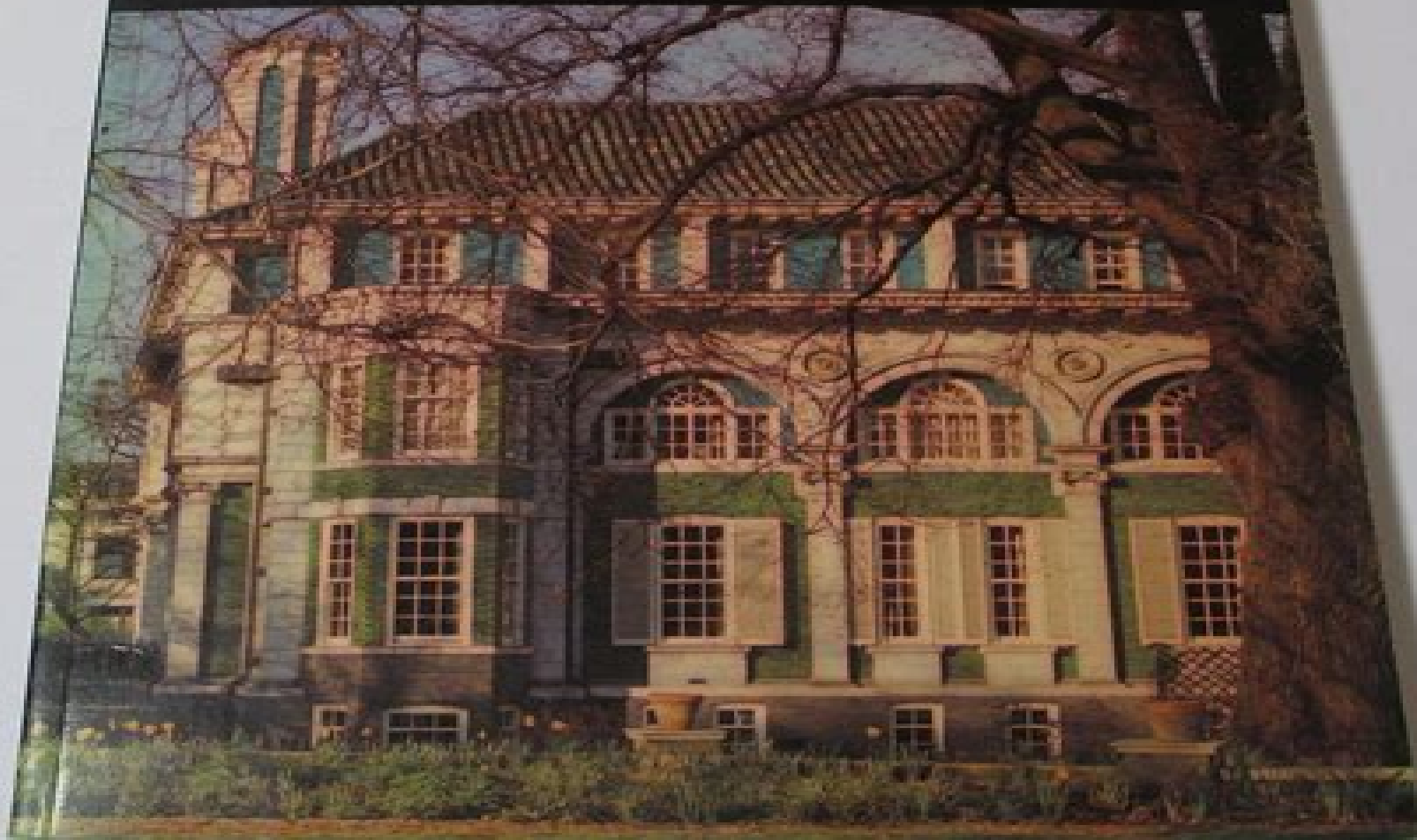

Architecture's public realm is thus analysed through sometimes surprising phrases and manners to understand ideals of public propriety, vigilance to explore public proprietorship, slump to contextualise the emergence of public relations, machine craft to understand the forging of public institutions.
