

Colour Plate XV Dark (wax-resin) eggs from Romania, where the local name for this type of work is *împănățat*. The lanterns (see dark eggs) were given to the Monastery of Putna in 1910-11, by villagers from the vicinity. The same applies to the right-hand vertical row of eggs, except the egg in the second row up. This egg is from Bradina in the same area as Putna, and so is the goose egg on its left (both 1911). The four hens' eggs in the left vertical row are also from the same region, Northern Moldavia, except the blue egg (uppermost) from the Bucharest district. The pair of eggs above the goose egg are again Moldavian, that on the right being another two is from Putna, Mădăria in Brașov Province (donated by Tare Biru). The unusual design of the red monochrome egg is based on the *Prisbeie*, an instrument used in the Orthodox and Greek Churches for preparing the Eucharist.
