In 1837, Lear's health started to decline. His deteriorating eyesight and failing lungs forced him to abandon the detailed painting required for depicting birds.

and with the help of the earl he moved to Rome where he established himself as a poet of literary nonsense While Lear was visiting the Earl of Derby he wrote poems and drew silly sketches to entertain the earl s children In 1846 he collected together his pile of limericks and illustrations and published his first poetical book titled A Book of Nonsense and dedicated to the Earl of Derby and his children He decided to publish under the pseudonym Derry down Derry but after he started making plans for more books he republished under his real name His next book Nonsense Songs Stories Botany and Alphabets wasn t published until 24 years later in 1870 Lear then released More Nonsense which contains more limericks in 1872 and Laughable Lyrics in 1877 This final book in the series contains many of Lear s most famous fantastical creatures such as the Quangle Wangle The influence of Lear s poetry in the twentieth century can be seen in styles like the surrealism movement and the theater of the absurd
