Kierkegaard's specific staging of his authorship in the contemporary life of Copenhagen then undergoing a rapid transformation from being the backward capital of an absolutist monarchy to a modern cosmopolitan city provides a further focus for the volume. In this situation the early Romantic experience of nature as providing a source of healing and an experience of unambiguous life is transposed into a more complex and ultimately catastrophic register. In articulating these tensions, Kierkegaard's authorship

provided a mirror to his age but also anticipated and influenced later generations who wrestled with their own versions of this situation
