The results also suggest that there may be trade offs between beneficial effects on growth and stability of some financial structures. For example, the positive association of financial buffers with growth can diminish above a certain relatively high threshold; a too safe system may limit the available funds for credit and hence growth.

Such evidence suggests that the southern European periphery industrial growth model has reached its limits demanding a multidimensional policy approach capable of overcoming the magnitude and complexity of the present crisis. Without denying the need to adjust public and private balance sheets it is argued that finding a sustainable path out of the present problems requires addressing the challenges of productivity growth and competitiveness in the long term.
