three of who are mentioned in the Biblical Old Testament Even when Nubians were expelled from Egypt by foreign Assyrian invaders they retreated to Napata to carry on their ancient state for three more independent centuries as Egyptian remained conquered by various foreigners for 2 500 years Most notable of these foreign conquerors of Egypt were the Greeks Ptolemies and the Roman who arrived and polytheists and left as Christians During this Greco Roman period in Egypt Nubians strategically withdrew still further south to the Kingdom of Mero from the 4th century BCE to the 4th century CE Meroe is also covered in great detail as it was famed for many regnant queens a unique and undeciphered writing system iron production and important monumental works including more pyramids than found in Egypt Yes smaller and later but many more pyramids that are still standing in several World Heritage sites in Nubia After Mero began a long decline it was finally vulnerable to attack from Christian Axum on the 4th century CE Two murky centuries of regional rule known as the X Group were to follow but by the 6th century Nubians recreated three Christian states that are covered in detail in the following Historical Dictionary of Medieval Christian Nubia and the Historical Dictionary of Sudan for Islamic and modern times
