PUBLIC POLICY

Public policy refers to the government's stance toward, and efforts to address, issues of public concern.

DEFINITION

Peters defines public policy as "...the set of activities that governments engage in for the purpose of changing their economy and society" (2015). Public policy decisions are primarily made by the government, although they can sometimes involve non-profit organizations and citizens (experts, stakeholders, etc.) (Brandsen, 2022). Various scholars conceive public policy in different ways.

EXAMPLE

Public Health Policy: The government's health policy covers aspects such as providing healthcare access to everybody, ensuring affordability and quality, tackling public health emergencies, and so on. Many countries, such as Canada and the United Kingdom, have centrally managed health systems with the goal of accessibility for all, while the USA has a more open-market system.
