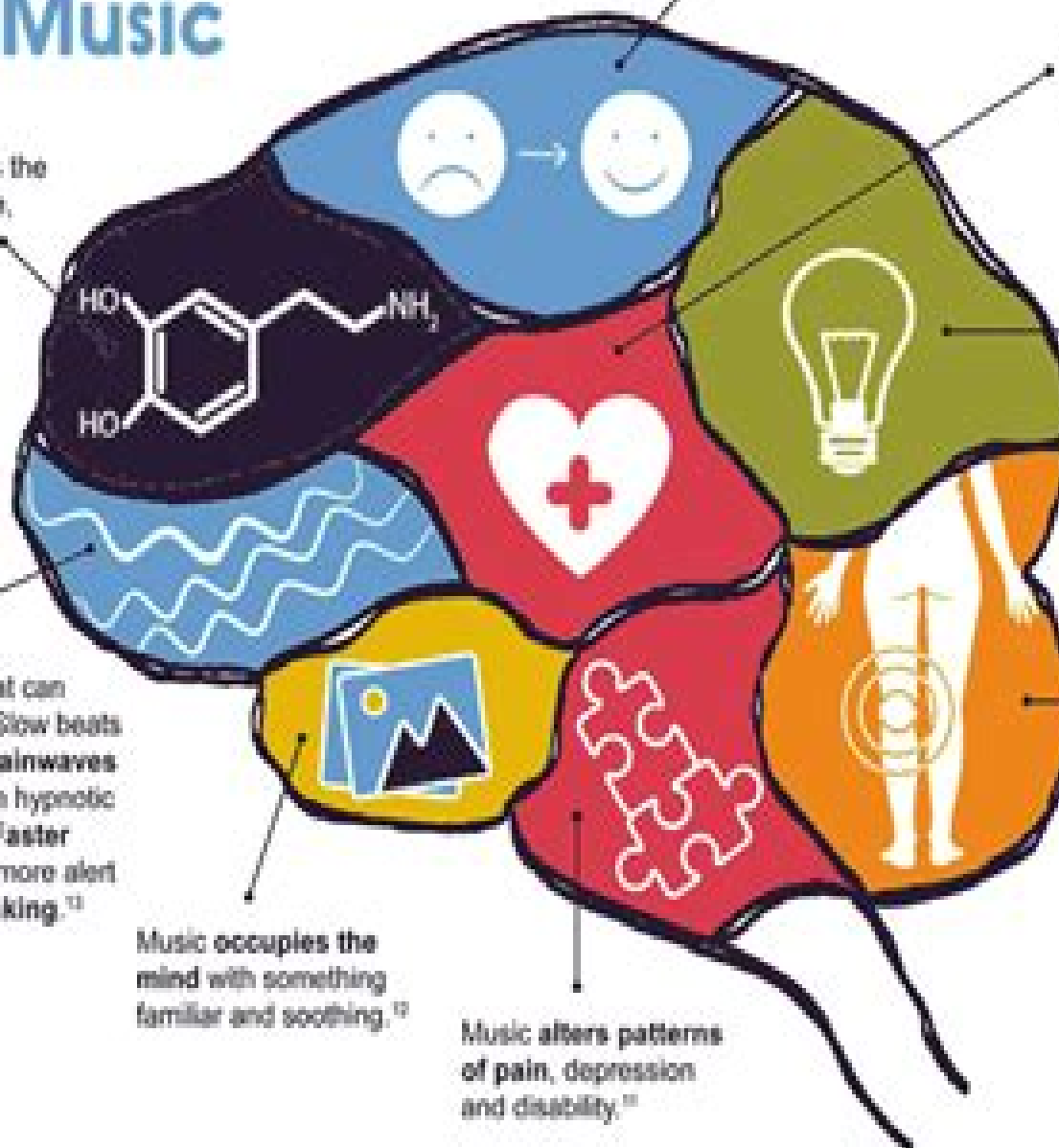


Your Brain On Music
