an agricultural estate owned by an elite Muslim family Among the unique finds is a large assemblage of locally produced handmade pottery which is thoroughly studied here The findings from the excavations at the Yotvata oasis have made a major contribution to the study of Early Islamic settlement and material culture in the greater Arabah region and beyond
