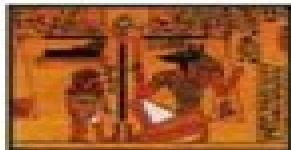
## SPELL CRISIS

Tut Tut, 9, announced the togethery turn-around after high-level discussions with palace advisors. "Amun is now top god again, and his shrines and statues will be making a

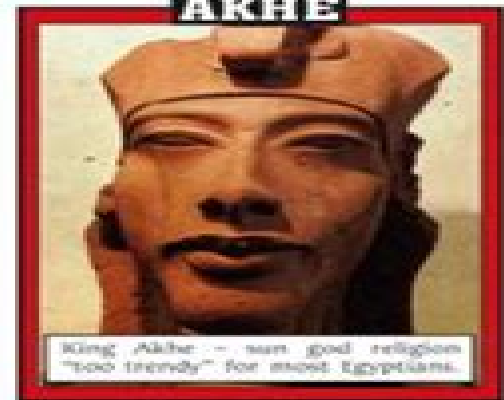


comeback," he told temple reporters gathered at his Memphis HQ yesterday.
