The acknowledgement that there is much more to recommend in his books than that which was praised by those who blinded by their commitment or because of imposed limitations on expectations showed no appreciation for the variety and subtlety of Steinbeck's writing explains the recent renaissance of interest in the whole of Steinbeck's oeuvre Indeed viewed without preconceived ideas and accepted for what they are it is impossible not to respond to Steinbeck's exploration of issues of freedom individual choice and relationships and not to notice that he was much more than merely a proletarian writer
