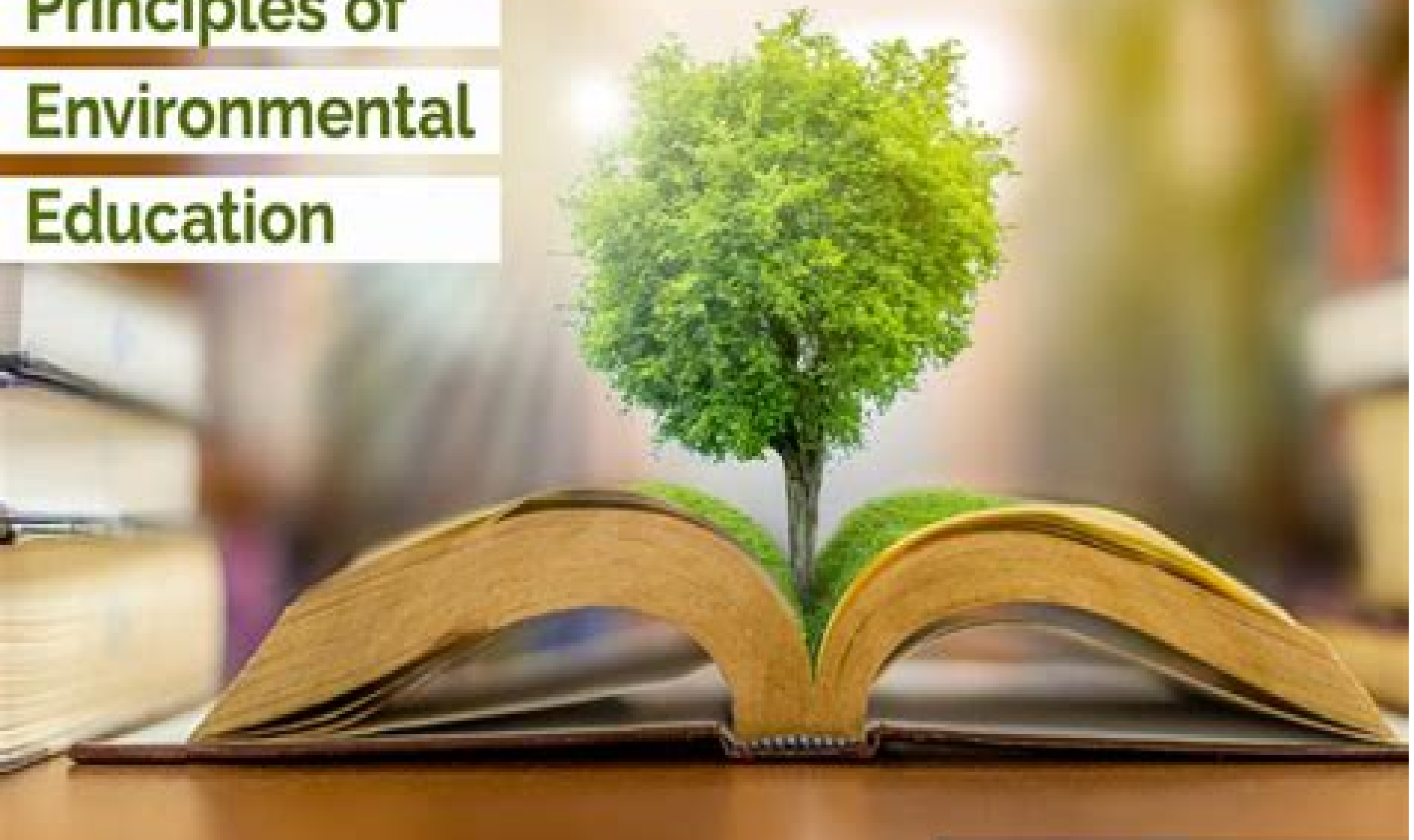

It was therefore appropriate that an international scientific body devote some time to the issue of ecology in education. Early in 1976 I suggested to the International Association for Ecology Inteco¹ that a symposium on Environmental Education be included in the program of the Second International Congress of Ecology scheduled to be held in Jerusalem in September 1978. In the first draft program of the Congress the topic was included as a poster session. I considered this inadequate and appealed to the Congress Steering Committee to focus greater attention on environmental education. The first draft program contained phrases like utilization of resources, conservation problems, environmental monitoring and irreversible changes. These phrases more or less assumed that people in general understood ecological principles. Literature on environmental education seems to suggest that a wide gap separated most of the professional ecologists from a large portion of mankind primarily because we the ecologists have paid scant attention to the ecological education of world's citizens.
