The book s emphasis on women s agency is significant because it highlights a flaw in earlier Western accounts of African women s lives under Africa s special brand of patriarchy that held women in total subjection to men. *Gender and Sexuality* debunks that trope and presents Ghanaian women s dynamism resilience and vulnerabilities embedded in the diverse cultures in which they live.
