beliefs or issues of reproduction As differences between times and cultures affect what can and cannot be said folkloric indirection may open up a vista to discourses of which we as readers may not even be aware Finally the folk women of Morrison N Dhuibhne Hurston and Lavin open up new points of entry to the discussion of fiction rhetoric censorship and folklore
