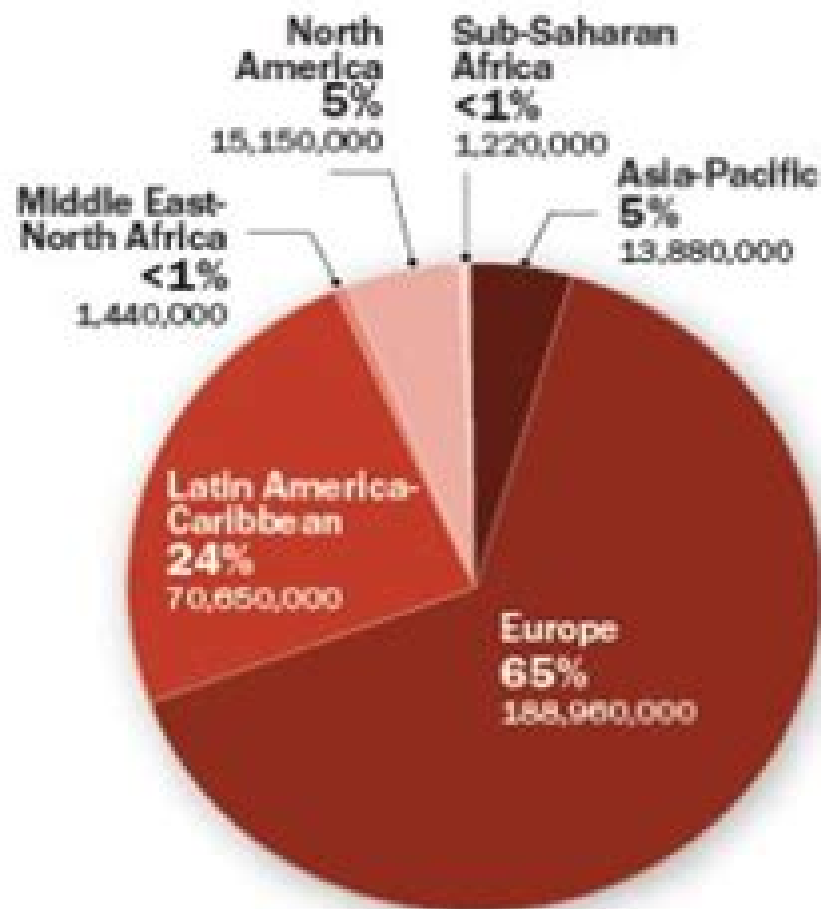


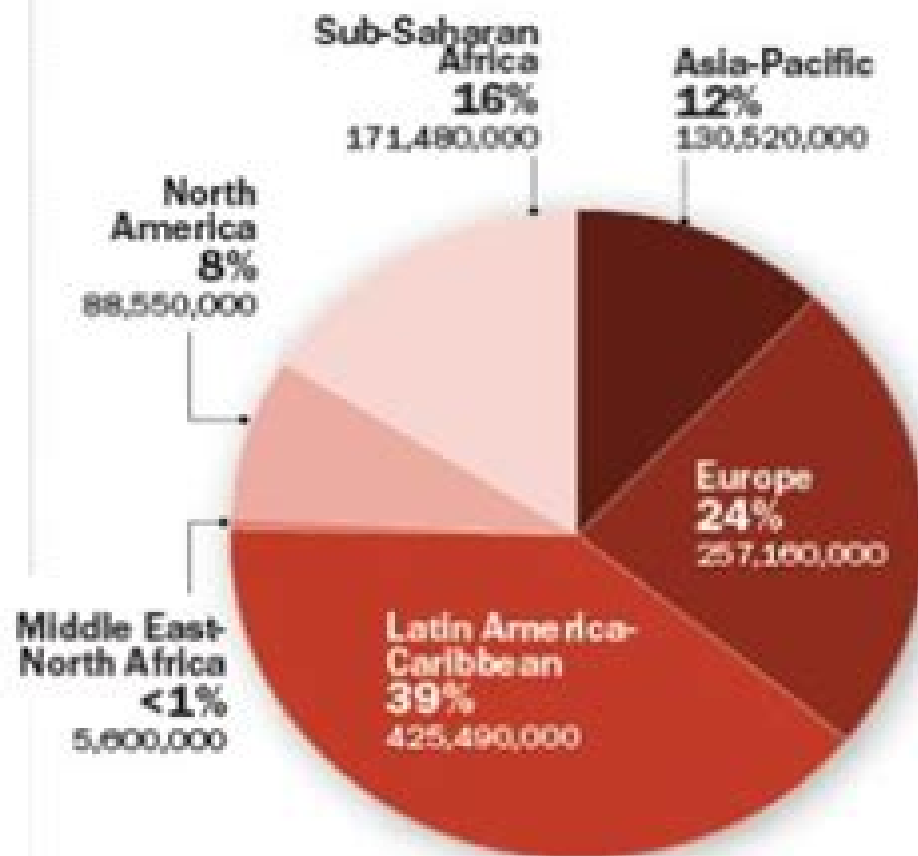
Regional Distribution of Catholics, 1910 and 2010
