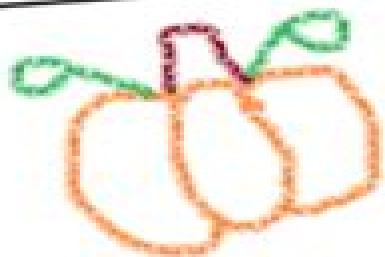

Students will write their pumpkin story and draw a picture to illustrate their story.



