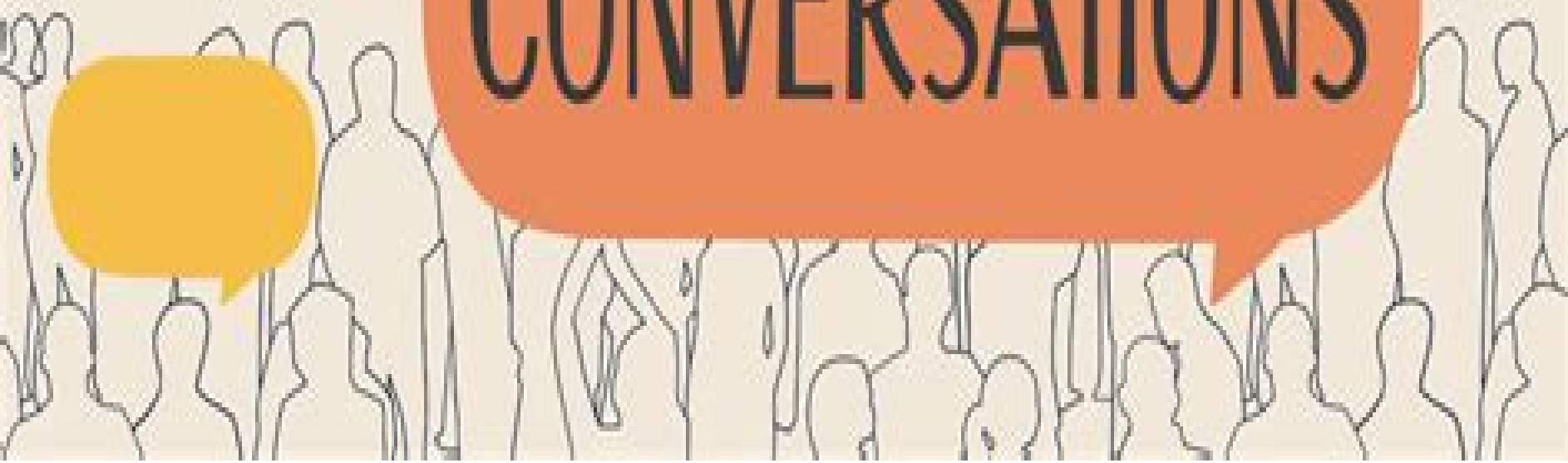

Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1958, volume 1 Witness Lee, Regarding Brother Witness Lee s travel and his ministry 1958 can be divided into approximately three periods The first period is the three months from January through March during which Brother Lee was in Manila Philippines in January and returned to Taipei Taiwan via Hong Kong in February He then conducted three conferences and a few co workers meetings in March The second period consists of the next six months from the beginning of April through mid October During this period Brother Lee traveled around the world passing through Tokyo Osaka and Shenyu in Japan April 8 through 22 Honolulu San Francisco Berkeley Los Angeles Chicago Detroit Pittsburgh New York City Washington D C and Toronto in the United States and Canada April 23 through August 1 London Copenhagen Glasgow Paris Brussels Amsterdam Hamburg Zurich Geneva Rome and Athens in Europe August 2 through September 21 Beirut Jerusalem and Tehran in the Middle East September 22 through 28 Karachi Rangoon now Yangon and Bangkok in South and Southeast Asia September 29 through October 3 and Hong Kong October 4 through 15 before returning to Taiwan on October 16 The third period consists of the last three months in Taiwan during which time he conducted various conferences For the first period we have records of Brother Lee s meeting with district responsible ones in Hong Kong on February 12 The three conferences that Brother Lee conducted in Taiwan in March were on the subject of

enjoying God This is the first time that Brother Lee released the light concerning this subject In addition to the three conferences Brother Lee conducted a number of meetings with serving ones on March 4 through 8 He also gave a series of messages on reading the Bible and another series of messages on the vision of the tree of life The messages given during this period are included in volume 1 of this set For the second period we have records of Brother Lee s speaking in Tokyo in April in a conference on enjoying God and records of a few private talks There are two records of his speaking in New York and four records of his speaking in Denmark In addition he wrote long letters that reveal some of the meetings that took place during his trip These letters are published in Church News in volume 1 of this set After his visits to the United States Europe and the Middle East he returned to Hong Kong in October There he held two weeks of conferences on God s building In the third period upon returning to Taiwan in October Brother Lee conducted a conference on God s building with meetings in both the morning and the evening In addition he conducted various meetings with serving ones After the conference on Mondays and Wednesdays he gave additional messages on the subject of God s building Almost all the messages given in the second and third periods of 1958 are included in volume 2 of this set Some of his speaking in October and November is included in volume 1 in the section entitled The Perfecting of the Saints and the Building Up of the House of God The Collected Works of Witness Lee 1958 volume 1 contains messages personal letters and reports by Brother Witness Lee from February through December 1958 Historical information concerning Brother Lee s travels and the content of his ministry in 1958 can be found in the general preface that appears at the beginning of this volume The contents of this volume are divided into seven sections as follows 1 A message given in Hong Kong on February 12 This message is included in this section under the title Building and Perfecting 2 A short speaking in an unknown location in February or March This speaking is included in this volume under the title The Son of Man 3 Ten messages given in Taipei Taiwan in March These messages were previously published in a book entitled Reading the Bible to See Its True Meaning and Central Thought and are included in this volume under the same title 4 Thirteen messages given in Taipei Taiwan in March October and November These messages were previously published in a book entitled The Perfecting of the Saints and the Building Up of the House of God and are included in this volume under the same title 5 Eighteen personal letters and reports that appeared in Issue Nos 1 through 18 of Church News from April 6 through December 18 They are included in this volume under the same title 6 Twenty one messages given in Taipei Taiwan in March These messages were previously published in a book entitled How to Enjoy God and How to Practice the Enjoyment of God and are included in this volume under the same title 7 Six messages given in Taipei Taiwan in March These messages were previously published in a book entitled The Vision of the Tree of Life and the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil and are included in this volume under the same title
