The Roosevelt Foreign-Policy Establishment and the "Good Neighbor" Randall Bennett Woods, 2021-10-08 The Good Neighbor Policy was tested to the breaking point by Argentina U S relations during World War II In part its durability had depended both upon the willingness of all American republics to join with the United States in resisting attempts by extrahemispheric sources to intervene in New World affairs and upon continuity within the United States foreign policy establishment During World War II neither prerequisite was satisfied Argentina chose to pursue a neutralist course and the Latin American policy of the United States became the subject of a bitter bureaucratic struggle within the Roosevelt administration Consequently the principles of nonintervention and noninterference together with absolute respect for the sovereignty of all states ceased to be the guideposts of Washington's hemispheric policy.
