Wareham, 2024-04-26 The only certainty in life is death Even the most powerful leaders throughout history were unable to cheat the Grim Reaper World leaders whether revered or reviled are rarely allowed to exit gracefully from life but instead receive a state funeral a major international event incorporating splendid symbols and messages religious faith and tradition The body of Tsar Alexander III was carried across half of Russia before finally being buried in St Petersburg People paid obscene amounts of money for a room that gave a glimpse of Queen Victoria s fascinating State funeral The cort ge for China s Empress Dowager Cixi was not to be photographed nevertheless photos showed up a century later For political reasons Generalissimo Franco s body was exhumed decades after his death The world became acquainted with a rather unusual ancient Roman Catholic ritual when Pope John Paul I died The body of India s Indira Gandhi was confined to sacred flames The last journey of Marshal Tito turned into an event of Funeral Diplomacy whilst Khomeini s funeral ended in frenzy and tumult In 2021 the massive restrictions imposed due to the Covid 19 pandemic meant a rigid downsizing of Prince Philip s funeral hardly any guests were allowed to attend This revealing and entertaining book provides an insight into unique obsequies from across the world seen as both a celebration of life and the honouring of death

governance The proliferation of pseudo history about liberation has further divided the polity between the two warring tribes who only glorify their respective idols Mujib and Zia Pre political and pre capitalist peasants lumpen elements lack of mutual trust and respect have further plagued Bangladesh turning it into one of the least governable corrupt and inefficient countries It is essential to replace the pre capitalist order of the country run by multiple lumpen classes with capitalist and inclusive institutions

Pakistan Dinkar Prakash Srivastava, 2025-06-03 The ideology of Pakistan is not defined but it has a pervasive influence over the state and society Ayub stated that this ideology is Islam General Asim Munir equates it with the Two Nation Theory The idea of a distinct Muslim identity was shaped by Sir Syed Ahmad Khan Iqbal and Jinnah They saw it in terms of conflict with the majority Hindu community This view was challenged by Maulana Madani who called for composite nationality He was criticized by Iqbal and Maududi In his famous speech of 11 August 1947 Jinnah said that religion has nothing to do with the business of the State This proved to be a short lived departure from his Two Nation Theory Kalquhistan who succeeded Jinnah as president of Pakistan's Muslim League has an interesting explanation for Jinnah's about turn The Lahore Resolution called for independent states Jinnah tried to change it to state This ambivalence could not be wished away and eventually led to the emergence of Bangladesh The Baloch struggle shows that the idea of nationality remains alive The Pakistan Army regards itself as the defender of the country's territorial and ideological frontiers Do its Afghanistan Kashmir and nuclear policies reflect ideologies strategies or territorial interests The Army's legitimacy is now being challenged by Imran's supporters The increasing radicalization of Pakistani society has implications beyond the region It is no coincidence that Al Qaeda's leadership found sanctuary in Pakistan after 9/11 Though the country has received twenty five IMF bailout packages its economy remains in a precarious state In *Pakistan Ideologies Strategies and Interests* Dinkar Srivastava traces Pakistan's
