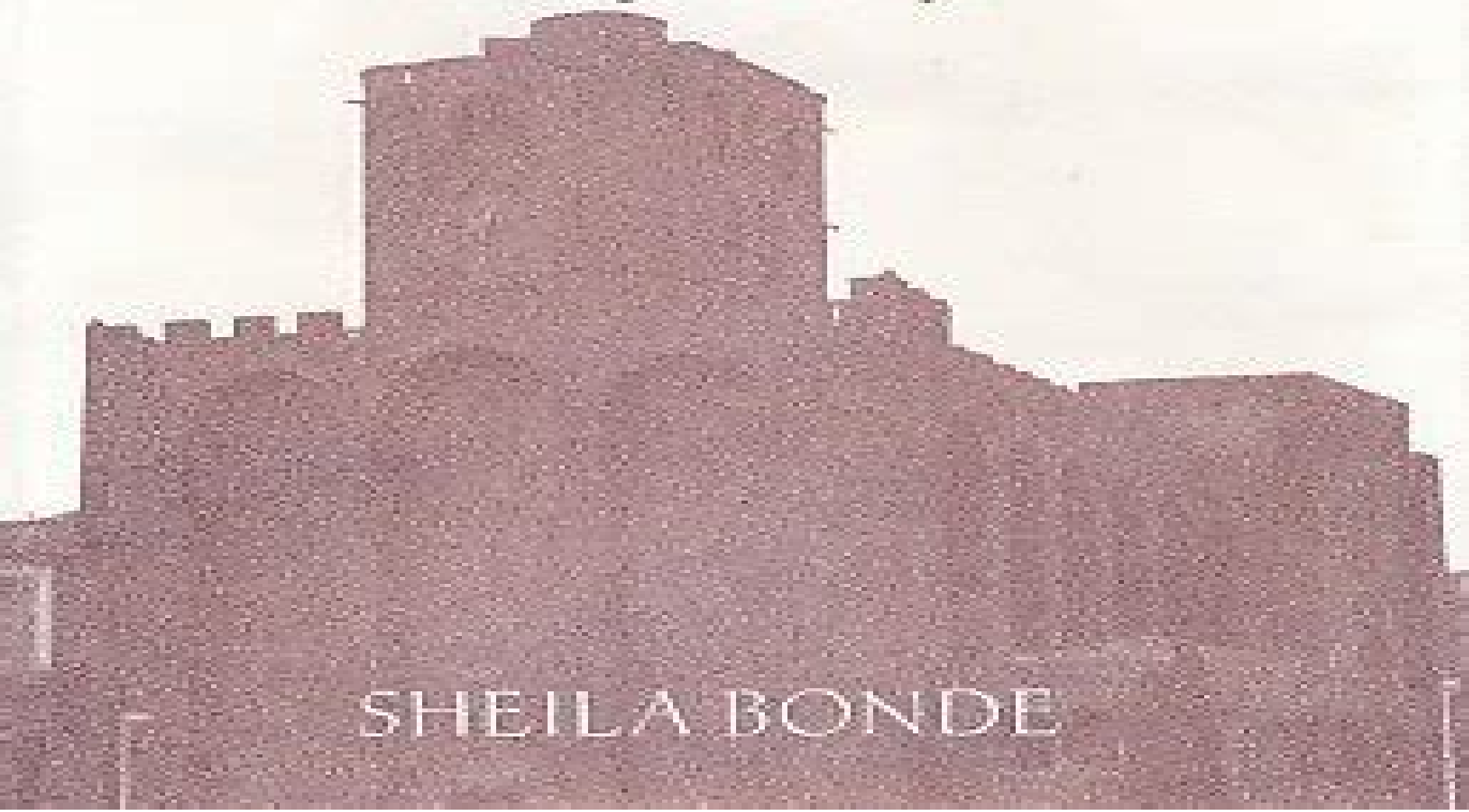

She analyses her archaeological surveys of these structures and also re-examines their documentation which is here presented both in the original Latin and in English translations.
