# Why?

Metaphysics may go beyond the interests of ordinary science because it takes place across several domains of science.

- Topics that are too general to be encompassed by a single domain (causation)
- Topics where our pre-theoretic intuitions play a role in theory choice (primitive ontology, direction of time, direction of causation), suggesting the need to investigate the origin or reliability of these intuitions (psychology).
- Questions about how domains relate.

Philosophy is likely to have a more significant role to play.

There will be metaphysics of science not practiced by scientists.
