which provided water storage facilities Tucson received no federal aid Moreover a significant cultural difference existed Tucson though it became a U S possession in 1853 always had a sizable Hispanic population Phoenix was settled in the 1870s by Anglo pioneers who brought their visions of landscape development and commerce with them By examining the factors of watershed culture ethnicity terrain political favoritism economic development and history Desert Cities offers a comprehensive evaluation that illuminates the causes of growth disparity in two major southwestern cities and provides a model for the study of bi city resource competition
