indigenous community into decades of grinding impoverishment landlessness and displacement The story of the Batwa of Kahuzi Biega is not an isolated incident Instead it is emblematic of the widespread systemic violence inherent in the rigidly colonial conservation model widely used in East and Central Africa funded and facilitated by a network of international entities with deadly consequences for indigenous peoples and local communities living in the vicinity of protected areas The tragic events detailed in this report have been made possible by a culture of impunity that devalues indigenous life in service of a highly militarized approach inherent in the fortress conservation model excluding the land s original inhabitants in violation of international law
