Before actual treatment is scheduled your doctor should run your necessary lab reports for blood urine and kidney functions Also should check your blood for metal toxicity and go over your medical history including blood pressure and blood sugar This would help your doctor to adjust your EDTA dosage and frequency of treatments Your doctor knows best Just follow his her advice If your primary doctor has covered some of these tests very recently you should take copies of these reports to this doctor if you can However I warn you if you will ask your primary doctor about Chelation therapy most probably he will not approve it You see main stream medical practitioners do not believe in these treatments However when it was their own health involved these same doctors in several cases have opted for Chelation

According to National Institute of Health over 800 000 patients opted for Chelation therapy in the United States in a single year Kindly note this process is also advisable for heart patients who have already gone through the bypass as chances are the vein grafts used in bypass do get clogged again within next year or
