Kott-Wolfe, whose parents and grandparents arrived in Canada in 1949, will discuss how the Museum helped research her family history; that history's influence on her art; the importance of preserving materials that document lives; and what it means to be Jewish for past, present, and future generations.

Growing Up Jewish Canadians Tell Their Own Stories:

Canada's Jews Gerald Tulchinsky, 2008-05-24 The history of the Jewish community in Canada says as much about the development of the nation as it does about the Jewish people Spurred on by upheavals in Eastern Europe in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries many Jews emigrated to the Dominion of Canada which was then considered little more than a British satellite state Over the ensuing decades as the Canadian Jewish identity was forged Canada itself underwent the transformative experience of separating itself from Britain and distinguishing itself from the United States In this light the Canadian Jewish identity was formulated within the parameters of the emerging Canadian national personality Canada's Jews is an account of this remarkable story as told by one of the leading authors and historians on the Jewish legacy in Canada Drawing on his previous work on the subject Gerald Tulchinsky illuminates the struggle against anti-Semitism and the search for a livelihood amongst the Jewish community He demonstrates that far from being a fragment of the Old World the Canadian Jewry grew from a tiny group of transplanted Europeans to a fully articulated diversified and dynamic national group that defined itself as Canadian while expressing itself in the varied political and social contexts of the Dominion Canada's Jews covers the 240 year period from the beginnings of the Jewish community in the 1760s to the present day illuminating the golden chain of Jewish tradition religion language economy and history as established and renewed in the northern lands With important points about labour immigration and anti-Semitism it is a timely book that offers sober observations about the Jewish experience and its relation to Canadian history *Growing Up Jewish* Irving M. Alice in Shandehland Monda Halpern, 2015-06-15 By 1931 Ben and Alice Edelson had been married for two decades and had seven children but for years Alice had been having an affair with the married Jack Horwitz On the night of 24 November Ben Alice and Jack met at Edelson Jewellers to settle the thing Words flew a brawl erupted and Jack was shot and killed The tragedy marked the start of a sensational legal case that captured Ottawa headlines with the prominent jeweller facing the gallows Through a detailed examination of newspaper coverage interviews with family and community members and evocative archival photographs Monda Halpern's Alice in Shandehland reconstructs a long silenced murder case in Depression era Canada Halpern contends that despite his crime Ben Edelson was the object of far less contempt than his adulterous wife whose shandeh Yiddish for shame or disgrace seemed indefensible While Alice endured the censure of both the Jewish community and the courtroom Ben's middle class respectability and the betrayal he suffered earned him favoured standing and ultimately legal exoneration Revealing the tensions around ethnicity sexuality gender and class Alice in Shandehland explores the divergent reputations of Ben and Alice Edelson within a growing but insular and tenuous Jewish community and within a dominant culture that embraced male success and valour during the emasculating 1930s

Authors Cynthia R. Comacchio and Neil Sutherland trace the lives of children over this long century with a view to synthesizing the rich interdisciplinary, often multi-disciplinary literature that has emerged since the 1970s. Integrated into this synthesis is the authors' new research into many often seemingly disparate archival and published primary sources. Emphasizing how the child and childhood are sociohistoric constructs and employing age analytically and relationally, they discuss the constants and the variants in their historic dimensions. While childhood tangibly modernized during these years, it remained a far from universal experience due to identifiers of race, gender, culture, region, and intergenerational adaptations that characterize the process of growing up. This work highlights children's perspectives through close critical readings of diaries, correspondence, memoirs, interviews, oral histories, and autobiographies, many buried in obscure archives. It is the only extant historical discussion of Canadian children that interweaves the experiences of First Nations, Métis, and Inuit children with those of children from a number of settler groups. *Ring Around the Maple* makes use of photographs, catalogues, advertisements, government publications, musical recordings, radio shows, television shows, material goods, documentary and feature films, and other such visual and aural testimony. Much of this evidence has not to date been used as historical testimony to uncover the lives of ordinary children. This book is generously illustrated with photographs and ephemera carefully selected to reflect children's lives, conditions, interests, and obligations.
