Montgolfier 9 km covered in 25 minutes on October 15 1783 see Le Globe below for first unmanned flight 2 months earlier Professor Jacques Charles and Les Fr res Robert two French brothers Anne Jean and Nicolas Louis variously shared three milestones of pioneering flight Le Globe the first unmanned hydrogen gas balloon flew on 26 August 1783 On 1 December 1783 La Charli re piloted by Jacques Charles and Nicolas Louis Robert made the first manned hydrogen balloon flight In 1951 the Lockheed XFV 1 and the Convair XFY tailsitters were both designed around the Allison YT40 turboprop engine drivin Florida Warbird Survivors 2002 Harold A.
