The only exceptions are a few books in this series of publications such as those on the Nile (Rz6ska 1976), the Volga (Morduckai Boltovskoi 1979) and the Amazon (Sioli 1984) and the recent compendium by Whitton (1984) on European rivers, among which there are a few that rate as large.
