Using case study evidence, they conclude that public policy often supports an unsustainable use of resources. To counter this, the authors propose policy and management options based on natural resource accounts, practical policy objectives, and the precautionary principle. *Economy and Ecosystems in Change* will be of interest to ecological, environmental, and resource economists and policymakers.
