



Follow the same procedure but focus your attention and concentration.

Do not concern yourself with how fast or slowly you read Your goal should be to understand the material, not to find out how fast you can complete it.

Critical reading tries to accomplish four goals:

- to recognize an author's purpose
- to understand tone and persuasive elements
- to recognize bias
- to analyse the value of what is written

To do this you need to consider the following questions:

What a text says - look for key themes

What a text does - look for discussion around key aspects

What a text means - analyses the text and look for meaning
