Louisa May Alcott, 2014-08-28 This unique collection includes pioneering feminist novels rare stories restored drawings and hard to find writings from the author of Little Women After the success of her beloved masterpiece Little Women Louisa May Alcott brought her genius for characterization and eye for detail to a series of revolutionary novels and stories that are remarkable in their forthright assertion of women s rights This second volume of The Library of America s Alcott edition gathers these works for the first time revealing a fascinating and inspiring dimension of a classic American writer The first of a trio of novels written over a fruitful three year period Work A Story of Experience has been called the adult Little Women It follows the semi autobiographical story of an orphan named Christie Devon who having turned twenty one announces a new Declaration of Independence and leaves her uncle s house in order to pursue economic self sufficiency and to find fulfillment in her profession Against the backdrop of the Civil War years Christie works as a servant actress governess companion seamstress and army nurse all jobs that Alcott knew from personal experience exposing the often insidious ways in which the employments conventionally available to women constrain their self determination Alcott s most overtly feminist novel Work breaks new ground in the literary representation of women as its heroine pushes at the boundaries of nineteenth century expectations and assumptions Eight Cousins concerns the education of Rose Campbell another orphan who in her delicate nature and frail health seems to embody many of the stereotypes of girlhood that shaped Alcott s world But with the benefit of an unorthodox progressive education and the good and bad examples of her many crisply drawn relations especially her seven boy cousins Rose regains her health and envisions a career both as a wife and mother and as a philanthropist She insists that she will manage her own fortune rather than find a husband to do it for her in the sequel Rose in Bloom This Library of America edition includes several noteworthy features All three novels are presented with beautifully restored line art from the original editions and are supplemented by seven hard to find stories and public letters two restored to print for the first time in more than a century an authoritative chronology of Alcott s life and notes identifying her allusions quotations and the autobiographical episodes in her fiction

James Thurber: Writings & Drawings (LOA #90) James Thurber, 1996-10-01 A comprehensive collection of the American humorist s best work including The Secret Life of Walter Mitty plus original drawings and a chronology of Thurber s own troubled life James Thurber whimsical fantasist and deadpan chronicler of everyday absurdities brought American humor into the 20th century His comic persona a modern city dweller

**Washington Irving: Three Western Narratives (LOA #146)** Washington Irving, 2004-01-26 America s first internationally acclaimed author Washington Irving established his fame with tales of the Hudson Valley in the days of Dutch rule and then spent seventeen years in Europe mining the Old World for stories When he finally returned to the United States he embarked on a trilogy of books on the American West that would prove decisive in molding his compatriots conception of the Great Plains the Rocky Mountains and the Pacific Northwest The Library of America presents this Western trilogy in its third volume of Irving s work Irving s own encounter with the West came in 1832 when he accompanied the Commissioner of Indian Affairs on a month long journey to what is now eastern Oklahoma His account of that trip A Tour on the Prairies 1835 described wild landscape rugged inhabitants and dramatic chases and hunts with an eye for romantic sublimity and a keen appreciation of the frontiersman s secret of personal freedom After the success of his first western book Irving undertook to write the history of John Jacob Astor s ultimately failed attempt to establish a fur trading empire in the Northwest In Astoria 1836 he created a sweeping epic of exploration commercial enterprise and contest for dominion on the shores of the Pacific drawing on Astor s rich archive of materials and enlivening it with his flair for vigorous storytelling In The Adventures of Captain Bonneville 1837 Irving focused on a single memorable figure an army officer and fur trader who may also have been an American spy tracking British ambitions in the far country to reveal the flavor of frontier life in the Rockies and beyond

**James: Writings 1902-1910 (LOA #38)** William James, 1988-02-01 Philosopher and psychologist William James was the best known and most influential American thinker of his time The five books and nineteen essays collected in this Library of America volume represent all his major work from 1902 until his death in 1910 Most were originally written as lectures addressed to general audiences as well as philosophers and were received with great enthusiasm His writing is clear energetic and unpretentious and is marked by the devotion to literary excellence he shared with his brother Henry James In these works William James champions the value of individual experience with an eloquence and enthusiasm that has placed him alongside Emerson and Whitman as a classic exponent of American democratic culture In The Varieties of Religious Experience 1902 James explores the very inner citadel of human life by focusing on intensely religious individuals of different cultures and eras With insight compassion and open mindedness he examines and assesses their beliefs seeking to measure religion's value by its contributions to individual human lives In Pragmatism 1907 James suggests that the conflicting metaphysical positions of tender minded rationalism and tough minded empiricism be judged by examining their actual consequences Philosophy James argues should free itself from unexamined principles and closed systems and confront reality with complete openness In A Pluralistic Universe 1909 James rejects the concept of the absolute and calls on philosophers to respond to the real concrete sensible flux of life Through his discussion of Kant Hegel Henri Bergson and religion James explores a universe viewed not as an abstract block but as a rich manyness in oneness full of independent yet connected

events *The Meaning of Truth* 1909 is a polemical collection of essays asserting that ideas are made true not by inherent qualities but by events James delights in intellectual combat stating his positions with vigor while remaining open to opposing ideas *Some Problems of Philosophy* 1910 was intended by James to serve both as a historical overview of metaphysics and as a systematic statement of his philosophical beliefs Though unfinished at his death it fully demonstrates the psychological insight and literary vividness James brought to philosophy Among the essays included are the anti-imperialist *Address on the Philippine Question* *On Some Mental Effects of the Earthquake* a candid personal account of the 1906 California disaster and *The Moral Equivalent of War* a call for the redirection of martial energies to peaceful ends as well as essays on Emerson the role of university in intellectual life and psychic research

**William Wells Brown: *Clotel & Other Writings* (LOA #247)** William Wells Brown, 2014-02-20 A showcase of the extraordinary career America's first Black novelist and pivotal figure in African American literature It is difficult to imagine any one of his contemporaries who contributed as much or as richly to so many genres Henry Louis Gates Jr Born a slave and kept functionally illiterate until he escaped at age nineteen William Wells Brown 1814-1884 refashioned himself first as an agent of the Underground Railroad then as an antislavery activist and self-taught orator and finally as the author of a series of landmark works that made him like Frederick Douglass a foundational figure of African American literature His controversial novel *Clotel; or, The President's Daughter* 1853 a fictionalized account of the lives and struggles of Thomas Jefferson's black daughters and granddaughters is the first novel written by an African American This Library of America volume brings it together with Brown's other groundbreaking works *Narrative of William W Brown A Fugitive Slave Written by Himself* 1847 his first published book and an immediate bestseller which describes his childhood life in slavery and eventual escape later memoirs charting his life during the Civil War and Reconstruction the first play *The Escape; or, A Leap for Freedom* 1858 travelogue *The American Fugitive in Europe* 1855 and history *The Black Man: His Antecedents, His Genius, and His Achievements* 1862 written by an African American and eighteen speeches and public letters from the 1840s 50s and 60s many collected here for the first time

**Mark Twain: *Historical Romances* (LOA #71)** Mark Twain, 1994-08-01 In the three novels collected in this Library of America volume

Mark Twain turned his comic genius to a period that fascinated and repelled him in equal measure medieval and Renaissance Europe This lost world of stately pomp and unspeakable cruelty artistic splendor and abysmal ignorance the seeming opposite of brashly optimistic commercial democratic nineteenth century America engaged Twain's imagination inspiring a children's classic and astonishing fantasy of comedy and violence and an unusual fictional biography Twain drew on his fascination with impersonation and the theme of the double in *The Prince and the Pauper* 1882 which brilliantly uses the device of identical boys from opposite ends of the social hierarchy to evoke the tumultuous contrasts of Henry VIII's England As the pauper Tom Canty is raised to the throne while the rightful heir is cast out among thieves and beggars Twain sustains one of his most compelling narratives A perennial children's favorite the novel brings an impassioned American point of view to the injustices of traditional European society A Connecticut Yankee in King Arthur's Court 1889 finds Twain in high satiric form When hard-headed Yankee mechanic Hank Morgan is knocked out in a fight he wakes up in Camelot in A.D. 528 and finds himself pitted against the medieval rituals and superstitions of King Arthur and his knights In a hilarious burlesque of the age of chivalry and of its cult in the nineteenth century American South Twain demolishes knighthood's romantic aura to reveal a brutish violent society beset by ignorance But the comic mood gives way to a darker questioning of both ancient and modern society culminating in an astonishing apocalyptic conclusion that questions both American progress and Yankee ingenuity as Camelot is undone by the introduction of advanced technology Taking into account her origin youth sex illiteracy early environment and the obstructing conditions under which she exploited her high gifts and made her conquest in the field and before the courts that tried her for her life she is easily and by far the most extraordinary person the human race has ever known So Twain wrote of the heroine of *Personal Recollections of Joan of Arc* 1896 his most elaborate work of historical reconstruction A respectful and richly detailed chronicle by turns admiring and indignant Joan of Arc opens a fascinating window onto the moral imagination of America's greatest comic writer
