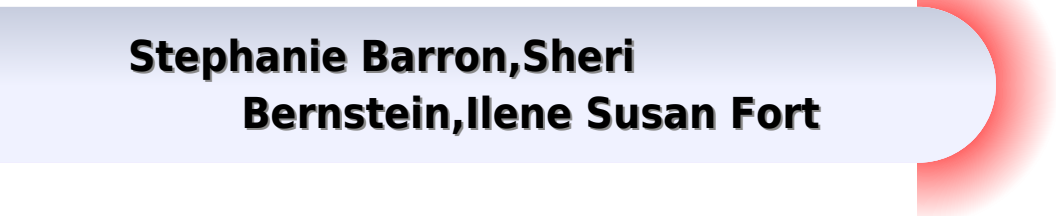

Waldie, Ed Ruscha, 2016-07-12 The renowned artist Ed Ruscha was born in Nebraska, grew up in Oklahoma, and has lived and worked in Southern California since the late 1950s. Beginning in 1956, road trips across the American Southwest furnished a conceptual trove of themes and motifs that he mined throughout his career. The everyday landscapes of the West, especially as experienced from the automobile—gas stations, billboards, building facades, parking lots, and long stretches of roadway—are the primary motifs of his often deadpan and instantly recognizable paintings and works on paper, as well as his influential artist books such as *Twentysix Gasoline Stations* and *All the Buildings on the Sunset Strip*. His iconic word images declaring *Adios Rodeo*, *Wheels over Indian Trails*, and *Honey I Twisted through More Damn Traffic to Get Here* further underscore a contemporary Western sensibility. Ruscha's interest in what the real West has become and Hollywood's version of it plays out across his oeuvre. The cinematic sources of his subject matter can be seen in his silhouette pictures, which often appear to be grainy stills from old Hollywood movies. They feature images of the contemporary West, such as parking lots and swimming pools, but also of its historical past: covered wagons, buffalo, teepees, and howling coyotes. Featuring essays by Karin Breuer and D.J. Waldie, plus a fascinating interview with the artist conducted by Kerry Brougher, this stunning catalogue produced in close collaboration with the Ruscha studio offers the first full exploration of the painter's lifelong fascination with the romantic concept and modern reality of the evolving American West. in Australian aboriginal art ukiyo e prints poetry literature and the history of philosophy He enjoyed secreting obscure art historical references into his work animals might assume postures found in Medieval or Renaissance art or a drawing that appears to depict a comic book character may in fact refer to Titian s triple headed allegory of Prudence This engaging publication presents gorgeous color reproductions of 150 of De Forest s finest artworks plus a variety of figure illustrations that illuminate the artist s diverse sources and freewheeling social and creative milieu in Northern California Provided by publisher

*Ray Stanford Strong, West Coast Landscape Artist* Mark Humpal,2017-12-14 Throughout his long and prolific career Ray Stanford Strong 1905 2006 strove to capture the essence of the western American landscape An accomplished painter who achieved national fame during the New Deal era

Strong is best known for his depiction of landscapes in California and Oregon rendered in his signature plein air style. This beautiful volume featuring more than 100 color and black and white illustrations is the first comprehensive exploration of Strong's life and artistry. Through family papers, archives, photographs, and a two-year series of interviews conducted with the artist personally, Mark Humpal traces Strong's journey from his childhood on an Oregon berry farm to his artistically formative years in New York and San Francisco. After moving back to the West Coast, Strong produced important works for the WPA, executed major diorama projects for two world expositions, helped organize the Santa Barbara Art Institute, and served as teacher and mentor for a new generation of plein air artists. But as Humpal emphasizes, Strong distinguished himself by resisting the drumbeat of the avant garde. During an era when many artists were experimenting with abstract expressionism, Strong never relinquished his personal vision and adherence to a more traditional style. With his outgoing personality, he forged friendships and associations with such prominent artists as Frank Vincent DuMond, Maynard Dixon, Ansel Adams, Frank Lloyd Wright, and John Steinbeck. Ultimately, Strong had little concern for his place in the sweep of art history. The proficiency he achieved through years of formal and informal study allowed him to craft a personal style difficult to categorize but unique and engaging. By expanding our understanding and appreciation of Strong's artistic contributions, this book offers a fitting tribute to one of America's finest landscape artists.
