Atomic Environments Neil Shafer Oatsvall, 2023-02-21 In *Atomic Environments* Neil S Oatsvall examines how top policymakers in the Truman and Eisenhower administrations used environmental science in their work developing nuclear strategy at the beginning of the Cold War While many people were involved in research and analysis during the period in question it was at highest levels of executive decision making where environmental science and nuclear science most clearly combined to shape the nation s policies Because making and testing weapons dealing with fallout and nuclear waste and finding uses for radioactive byproducts required advanced understanding of how nuclear systems interacted with the world policymakers utilized existing networks of environmental scientists particularly meteorologists geologists and ecologists to understand and control the United States use of nuclear technology Instead of profiling individuals Oatsvall focuses on executive institutions especially the leadership of the Atomic Energy Commission AEC and high level officials in the Truman and Eisenhower White Houses including the presidents themselves By scrutinizing institutional policymaking practices and agendas at the birth of the nuclear age a constant set of values becomes clear *Atomic Environments* reveals an emerging technocratic class that consistently valued knowledge about the environment to help create and maintain a nuclear arsenal despite its existential threat to life on earth and the negative effects many nuclear technologies directly had on ecosystems and the American people alike *Atomic Environments* is divided into five chapters each of which probes a different facet of the entanglement between environment nuclear technologies and policymaking The first three chapters form a rough narrative arc about nuclear weapons Chapter One situates bombs in their natural habitat by considering why nuclear tests occurred where they did and what testers thought they revealed about the natural environment and how they influenced it Focusing on nuclear fallout Chapter Two argues that nuclear tests actually functioned as a massive uncontrolled experiment in world environments and human bodies that intermingled medicine nuclear science and environmental science Chapter Three shows how the environmental knowledge gained in the first two chapters led to nuclear test ban treaty talks during the Eisenhower era when the advancement of environmental knowledge and the natural world itself became crucial grounds of contention in the creation of nuclear test detection and evasion systems The last two chapters step away from weapons to question how other nuclear technologies and facets of the U S nuclear program interacted with the natural world Chapter Four examines agriculture s place in the U S nuclear program from breakthrough advances in agricultural science including the use of radioisotopes and the direct application of radiation

to food to atomic agriculture's public relations value as a peaceful proxy which shifted the moral calculus and further leveraged the U S government's atomic power Chapter Five shows how knowledge of the natural world and the functioning of its systems proved important to uncovering the most effective ways to dispose of nuclear waste Running throughout Oatsvall consistently demonstrates how the natural world and the scientific disciplines that study it became integral parts of nuclear science rather than adversarial fields of knowledge But while nuclear technologies heavily depended on environmental science to develop those same technologies frequently caused great harm to the natural world Moreover while some individuals expressed real anxieties about the damage wrought by nuclear technologies policymakers as a class consistently made choices that privileged nuclear boosterism and secrecy prioritizing institutional values over the lives and living systems that agencies like the AEC were ostensibly charged to protect In the end Oatsvall argues that although policymakers took their charge to protect and advance the welfare of the United States and its people seriously they often failed to do so because their allegiance to the U S nuclear hierarchy blinded them to the real risks and dangers of the nuclear age

postphenomenological research methodology must consist of **The Dance on the Feet of Chance** Hooman Attar,2010-12-02 Corporations have problems dealing with the indeterminate aspects of innovation particularly in the early fuzzy front end of the process They have difficulty in reflecting upon and handling uncertainties of innovation often exhibiting a dynamic conservatism or a set of defensive routines that inhibit inquiry about such contentious issues They prefer and are better equipped to operate within the language of investment than the language of invention In the language of investment corporations select an environmental niche and attempt to program and fabricate its future according to rational stable assumptions and formulations This view is closely bound to a utopian image of risk management as a tool able to objectively map measure and monitor future uncertainties that govern the behavior of the chosen niche By seeking a close and clear fit between risk management solutions means and the dominant factors that determine future threats and opportunities to the niche environment ends corporations attempt to master risks and colonize the future through an orderly process It is the argument of this book that this approach is only good when targeting and solving well defined problems of risk management and innovation within an intellectual terrain that has already been intellectually set It fails to systematically recognize reflect upon and improve the effectiveness of the complex and creative task undertaken in the prior stage of problem setting or risk settling In contrast to this approach it is argued that in ill defined unique and uncertain situations problem setting or risk settlement are the key primary activities and problem solving or risk management only secondary This study as its strategic objective seeks to juxtapose these contrasting views and develop an integrated conceptual framework capable of supporting a reflective practice amongst practitioners grappling with the interplay between risk settlement and risk management at the fuzzy front end of innovation This framework strongly influenced by Donald Sch n s scholarly work takes the form of a set of concepts designed to synthesize mobilize and focus a wide range of academic literature on managing risk and handling uncertainty in product innovation It informs reflections on professional practice through pragmatist existential explorations
