Boer, 2015-04-20 The Sacred Economy of Ancient Israel offers a new reconstruction of the economic context of the Bible and of ancient Israel. It argues that the key to ancient economies is with those who worked on the land rather than in intermittent and relatively weak kingdoms and empires. Drawing on sophisticated economic theory especially the Regulation School and textual and archaeological resources, Roland Boer makes it clear that economic crisis was the norm and that economics is always socially determined. He examines three economic layers: the building blocks, five institutional forms, periods of relative stability, three regimes, and the overarching mode of production. Ultimately, the most resilient of all the regimes was subsistence survival, for which the regular collapse of kingdoms and empires was a blessing rather than a curse. Students will come away with a clear understanding of the dynamics of the economy of ancient Israel. Boer's volume should become a new benchmark for future studies.

This resulted in inconsistencies and evasions in his final essays, which greatly upset the orthodox contingent.
