Mohl, 2020-10-15 A must read for anyone interested in the history of civil rights the roles and varied motivations of southern Jews in the movement the interaction of blacks and Jews the role of hate groups and the anti communist hysteria in silencing or harassing the forces of positive change and the specific place of Miami Miami Beach and Florida in the struggle Raymond Mohl s writing style is dynamic and fully accessible for the lay as well as scholarly audience that I expect this work will attract Mark K Bauman Atlanta Metropolitan College Using unusual and revealing primary materials from the careers of two remarkable Jewish women Raymond Mohl offers an original interpretation of the role of Jewish civil rights activists in promoting racial change in post World War II Miami He describes the city's political climate after the war as characterized by segregation aggressive anti Semitism and a powerful strain of cold war McCarthyism In this hostile environment the dynamic leadership of two northern newcomers Matilda Bobbi Graff and Shirley M Zoloth played a critical role in the city's campaign for racial reform Working with the Miami chapter of the Civil Rights Congress established in 1948 Graff was instrumental in the organization s stand against the Ku Klux Klan its protests against lynchings and police brutality and its work with Florida's black civil rights leaders such as Harry T Moore With the Miami Congress of Racial Equality Zoloth helped to launch a lunch counter sit in campaign a year before the more famous student sit ins of 1960 that ultimately resulted in the desegregation of downtown public accommodations This analysis of the movement between 1945 and 1960 substantiates a new but now dominant interpretation of civil rights history that sees grassroots action as the powerful engine that drove racial change It emphasizes the major role played by women in the cause and documents the variety of civil rights experiences of Jews who migrated to Miami in large numbers during the mid century decades Committed to social justice they built activist organizations challenged segregationists and anti Semites and worked with black activists to break down Jim Crow barriers Original documents written by both women including Graff's autobiographical memoir demonstrate a level of Jewish activism especially by women that was unique for the time and place the postwar American South Their own words vividly describe fear harassment family and community pressures government intrigue and individual betrayal As Mohl s groundbreaking history illustrates the perseverance of these women and their small band of supporters is a testament to their strength and an inspiration for continued reform in America Raymond A Mohl professor of history at the University of Alabama Birmingham is the editor of Searching for the Sunbelt Historical Perspectives on a Region and the coeditor of The New African American Urban History and Urban Policy in Twentieth Century America A New Vision of Southern Jewish History Mark K. Olson, 2018-11-15 This study examines the role of the Six Day War in all people American Protestant politics and culture The author argues that American foreign policy towards the Arab Israeli conflict culminating in the Trump Administration s 2017 recognition of Jerusalem as Israel s capital and the domestic Evangelical communities who supported it has a direct correlation with the long term consequences of the 1967 Six Day War For most of America's history biblical literalists or Evangelicals dominated the religious culture of the country But in 1925 the Scopes trial on science evolution and religion embarrassed Evangelicals and caused them to retreat from American culture and politics Modern and liberal Protestants won dominance and established control in nearly all of the Mainline seminaries publishing houses and denominations leading to the creation of the National Council of Churches by 1950 This book argues that the Six Day War reversed that power structure in American religion with Evangelicals returning to a place of prominence in American culture and politics Whereas the Scopes trial showed much of American Protestantism that the Modernists had the right understanding of the Bible the Six Day War demonstrated that ironically Evangelicals may have had it right all along They used this historic leverage to vaunt themselves into the highest planes of American life with Billy Graham becoming America's Pastor In this historic process the 1967 war between Israel and the surrounding Arab states

clarified the way those different branches of American Protestantism thought about the Arab Israeli conflict particularly the issue of Jerusalem Indeed the nature of the Six Day War was deep and appeared to be of Biblical proportions Because Israel gained territories in Jerusalem Bethlehem and the ancient Biblical heartlands formerly held by Jordan historical messianic and even apocalyptic intrusions entered the various branches of American Protestantism In some branches supersessionism a belief that the Church had replaced the Jewish people as God's chosen was stoked In other branches supersessionism was rejected and the nature of Judaism and its connection to the Holy Land was re evaluated The important point is that the territories that Israel captured had thick theological meaning and this would force all branches of American Protestantism to reconsider their assumptions about Judaism and Zionism as well as Islam and Palestinian nationalism Evangelicalism

Ferziger, 2015-07-15 In 1965 social scientist Charles S Liebman published a study that boldly declared the vitality of American Jewish Orthodoxy and went on to guide scholarly investigations of the group for the next four decades As American Orthodoxy continues to grow in geographical institutional and political strength author Adam S Ferziger argues in Beyond Sectarianism The Realignment of American Orthodox Judaism that one of Liebman's principal definitions needs to be updated While Liebman proposed that the committed Orthodox observant rather than nominally affiliated could be divided into two main streams church or Modern Orthodoxy and sectarian or Haredi Orthodoxy Ferziger traces a narrowing of the gap between them and ultimately a realignment of American Orthodox Judaism Ferziger shows that significant elements within

Haredi Orthodoxy have abandoned certain strict and seemingly uncontested norms He begins by offering fresh insight into the division between the American sectarian Orthodox and Modern Orthodox streams that developed in the early twentieth century and highlights New York s Congregation Kehilath Jeshurun as a pioneering Modern Orthodox synagogue Ferziger also considers the nuances of American Orthodoxy as reflected in Soviet Jewish activism during the 1960s and early 1970s and educational trips to Poland taken by American Orthodox young adults studying in Israel and explores the responses of prominent rabbinical authorities to Orthodox feminism and its call for expanded public religious roles for women Considerable discussion is dedicated to the emergence of outreach to nonobservant Jews as a central priority for Haredi Orthodoxy and how this focus outside its core population reflects fundamental changes In this context Ferziger presents evidence for the growing influence of Chabad Hasidism what he terms the Chabadization of American Orthodoxy Recent studies including the 2013 Pew Survey of U S Jewry demonstrate that an active and strongly connected American Orthodox Jewish population is poised to grow in the coming decades Jewish studies scholars and readers interested in history sociology and religion will appreciate Ferziger's reappraisal of this important group Learning on the Left Stephen J.
