The blank pages marked for 1917 and 1918 are almost as informative as the fearful excitement captured at the onset of that tremendous conflict This is a strong narrative of the war easy to read mixing news with personal feelings and events often revealing gap between official news and reality Also included are several poems written by Mabel and a love story in the appendix giving a complete insight
