At the same time no one in the world had ever successfully built a bridge as long as this one would be and indeed no one else would for another three decades after the Golden Gate Bridge opened. Indeed it would take nearly 20 years from the time the bridge was proposed to its grand opening and it cost hundreds of millions of dollars the equivalent of several billion today.
