Gone to an Aunt's Petrie, Sir, Anne Petrie, 1999-04-17 Thirty or forty years ago everybody knew what that phrase meant a girl or a young unmarried woman had gotten herself pregnant She was in trouble She had brought indescribable shame on herself and her family In those days it was unthinkable that she would have her child and keep it Instead she had to hide Most likely she would be sent away to a home for unwed mothers where she would stay in secrecy until her baby was born and given up for adoption Gone to an aunt's was the usual cover story a fiction that everyone understood but no on talked about until now In Gone to an Aunt's journalist and long time television host Anne Petrie takes us back into these homes for unwed mothers Most cities in Canada had at least one home several as many as five or six most of them run by religious organizations.
