The next one is scheduled for the following day They also share a piece of information so shocking that Jackboy keeps it to himself knowing that no white man would ever believe it possible When Jackboy reports his findings Johnson realizes there is no time to seek approval from his commanders or wait for reinforcements They are the only ones who can prevent the mass slaughter of sixty men women and children
