

tion of these issues, the book is valuable as a collection of empirical case studies, which at times include some delightful personal insights. See, for example, Helen Clark's account of being a politician caught up in the politics of the pharmaceutical companies; Neil Pearce on trying to publish important information on the side-effects of Fenoterol, while behind the scenes a drug company bombards the journal editors with unsolicited reviews; and Alex Thomson's account of the 'bribes' offered to doctors by pharmaceutical companies, and the weak response by medical ethics committees to these very common practices. Also, it is encouraging to see epidemiologists like Jackson, Kawachi and Pearce grappling with their own discipline and showing how epidemiological knowledge has been used to promote dubious 'mass treatment' regimes. Overall, *For Health or Profit* will probably not make a healthy profit, but given the copious details provided of the avaricious pursuits of pharmaceutical companies, the editor and contributors may be happy to have added another voice critical of the powerful drug industry.

CO-OPERATIVE LIFESTYLES IN AUSTRALIA: FROM UTOPIAN DREAMING TO COMMUNAL REALITY

Bill Metcalf (ed.)

In an environment of rationalist economics practised at university and with my increasing sense of being bound to harder and faster outcome measurements defined somewhere beyond me, I found this a challenging and refreshing book. Challenging because the book is about people successfully struggling to exercise control and responsibility in their own lives through community, and refreshing because I frequently could

identify with the authors' vision, commitment, pragmatism and successes.

This is a book of ten stories (first person narratives by four men, five women and one couple) by and about people in small-scale communities ranging in size between five and 260. The introduction is an historical overview of Australian intentional communities by Bill Metcalf and he also supplies the summary and conclusions. The communities represented are located across Australia. A significant number of the authors are academics, and these are mostly sociologists or social scientists, so this makes for very 'warm' sociology.

This is also a book about multiculturalism in Australia, in the sense that those who choose intentional communities do so with a strong critique of some notion of 'mainstream' culture. Their analysis of the 'outside' of their vision of cultural/community preferences motivates the construction of community. The community cultures constructed would seem as strong and diverse as any associated with any ethnicity, sexuality, institutions, or urban or rural location, and yet currently they appear not to be constructed as threatening in popular discourse.

Many of the authors included in *Co-operative Lifestyles in Australia* discuss physical place (all communities represented are significantly rural) and community where the magnitude and potency of the global appear to intrude rather less than in lives of those 'outside'. Most authors however do work 'outside', although this work is not a focus for discussion. Perhaps the picture that emerges then is of life more 'sealed off' than longer conversations with authors might indicate. In *Co-operative Lifestyles in Australia*, the individual is supported and confined by, and struggles with, others in community or perhaps with local government. 'Outside' family and friends, Tibetan Llamas and Woofers are the only others who seem to drift in and out of the lives portrayed.

The autobiographical papers about intentional community are edited by Metcalf, himself an erstwhile participant in intentional communities, and a soci-
