Lo que hoy ilamamos el "territorio venezolano" no fue un todo integrado sino para finales del siglio XVIII y esa integración: tuvo que asimilarse y cristalizarse durante el período republicano. Este es uno de los aspectos más fundamentales de se historia que los autores lo analizan, como una necesidad de tenerio en mente para la cabal comprensión de Venezuela.

Una vez independiente, Venezuela vivió entre 1830-1860 momentos de serios problemas fronterizos, pues debió atender a la configuración de sus fronterias con Colombia, Brasil, Holanda y Guayana Británica. A partir de 1861, nuestro pels basó toda su diplomacia en la búsqueda del Arbitraje como solución frente a Colombia y Guayana Británica. Las dolorosas consecuencias de estos laudos, traducidas luego en las demarcaciones subsiguientes, sacrificaron los derechos de una Venezuela mayor.
