Foundations of Parasitology. 3rd. edition. By G. D. Schmidt and L. S. Roberts. 775pages. ISBN 0-8016-4385-6. Times Mirror/Mosby, St Louis, 1985. £33.50. (Distributed in the United Kingdom by Blackwell Scientific Publications.)

Student text-books of parasitology tend to fall into two categories - the encyclopaedic and the

selective. The former attempts to cover all groups of parasites and all aspects of parasitology; the latter aims to be more selective, dealing only with specific groups but using them to examine the biological basis for the phenomenon of parasitism. Both have their place in different sorts of student courses. The 3rd edition of this well-known text-book (previous editions, 1977, 1981) falls somewhere between these two approaches. There is a useful opening chapter dealing with basic principles and concepts, including an up-to-date section on immunology. In the main text, the coverage of parasitic species is very extensive, including parasitic arthropods as well as protozoa and helminths, and shows a nice balance between laboratory and clinical interests. The book is well illustrated, although the variety

of drawing styles taken from other authors does not altogether enhance the overall style of

presentation.
The basic academic text is lightened here and there with delightful snippets of parasitological history (see, for example, malaria) which bring home to the student the often tortuous way in which the subject has evolved.

The 3rd edition includes the latest classification of the Protozoa and has updated the 2nd edition in selected areas. Some elegant coloured plates have been added and there is an excellent Glossary. The disappointment for this edition (as with previous editions!) is the Index which is astonishingly poor for a volume of this size and content. For example, a student wishing to compare the hatching phenomenon in different groups, will search in vain for the word 'hatching' in the index. Similarly,

phenomenon in different groups, will search in vain for the word 'hatching' in the index. Similarly, there are almost no biochemical terms indexed, even basic words widely used in parasite physiology—
DNA, enzyme, glucose, oxygen etc—are missing. The result of this is that much of the valuable data in this text is often difficult to locate. Apart from this reservation, the book is a readable, comprehensive text for students of general parasitology, although advanced research workers may find it of more limited use.

- 1972 saw the publication of the proceedings of an important symposium on the behavioural ecology of host-parasite systems (Behavioural Aspects of Parasite Transmission) organized jointly by the Linnean Society of London and the British Society for Parasitology. Once again, 13 years on, the same two societies have collaborated to examine host-parasite interactions. This time the eleventh volume in the Linnean Society Symposium Series considers the ecological genetics and population ecology of parasitic associations and reports papers presented at a meeting held at Keele University in July 1984.

 This is a timely overview of an important growth area in modern parasitology. Until quite recently

it was possible to read much of the existing literature on the population biology of parasites and their hosts without seeing any evidence that proper attention was being paid to the fact that these populations of organisms were genetically heterogeneous. The 14 papers presented at this fascinating Symposium help to show that workers employing a wide range of methodological perspectives and using very different field and experimental systems have come to very similar conclusions about the importance of the genetic dimension in their studies.
