Professor of Social Welfare Policy at Fordham University Graduate Center and the founder and Director of the Fordham Institute for Innovation in Social Policy Luisa is Professor of Socioogy at Vassar College where she has served as Department Chair and Director of its Urban Studies Program Both earned Ph D degrees from the University of Chicago Since 1987 Marc has headed a research team to develop the Index of Social Health a nationally recognized social barometer that has been featured in ten New York Times and four Washington Post articles This index has commanded increasingly large electronic and print media attention because of its powerful presentation of trends in family life income health housing child poverty and other social indicators of everyday life in the United States
