

Ecrire l'histoire du XXe siècle Alain Besançon, 1994 **Ecrire l'histoire de l'Afrique à l'époque coloniale** Sophie Dulucq, 2009 Ecrire l'histoire de l'Afrique est une entreprise aux racines plus anciennes qu'on ne le croit généralement.
