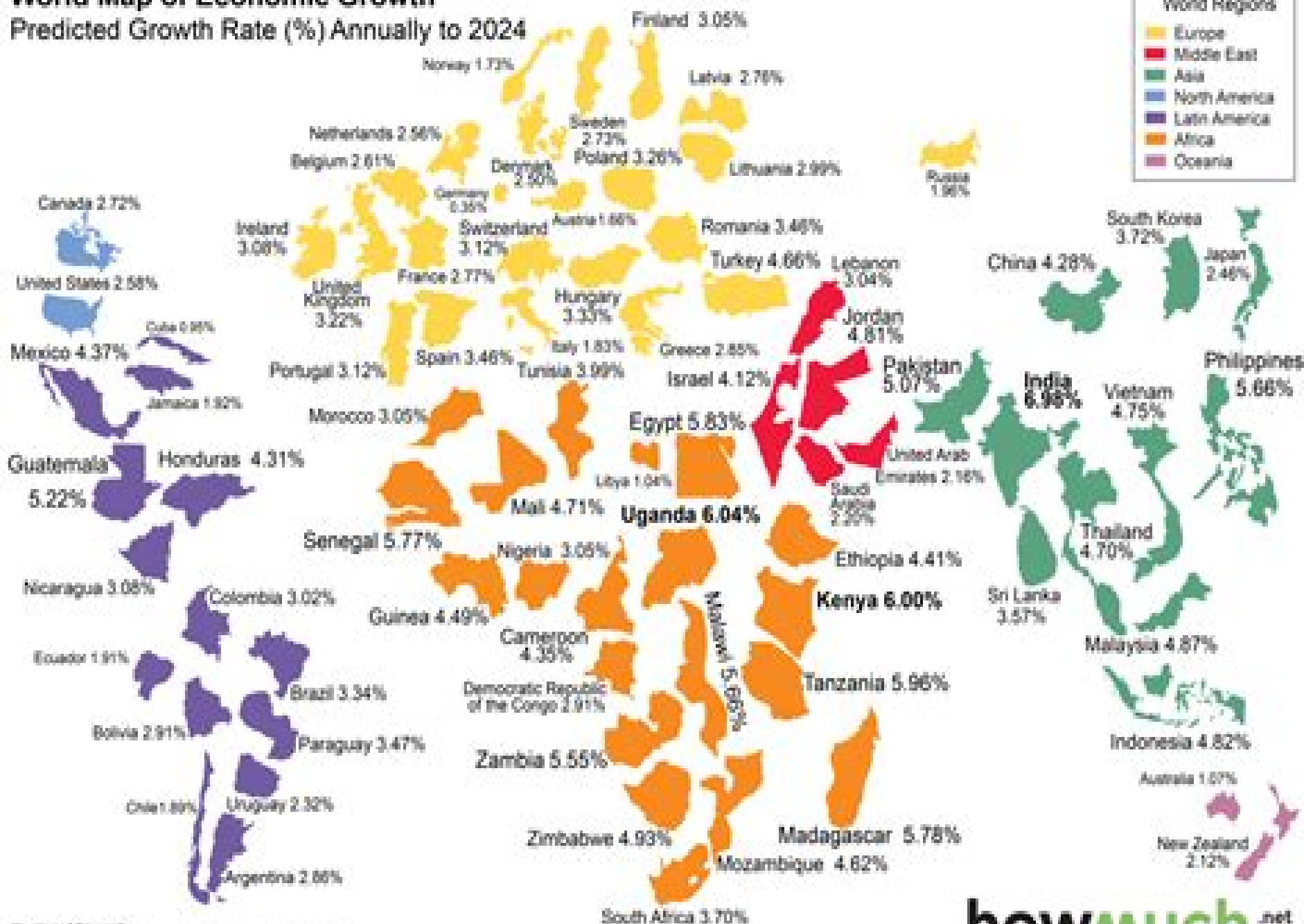


# World Map of Economic Growth
