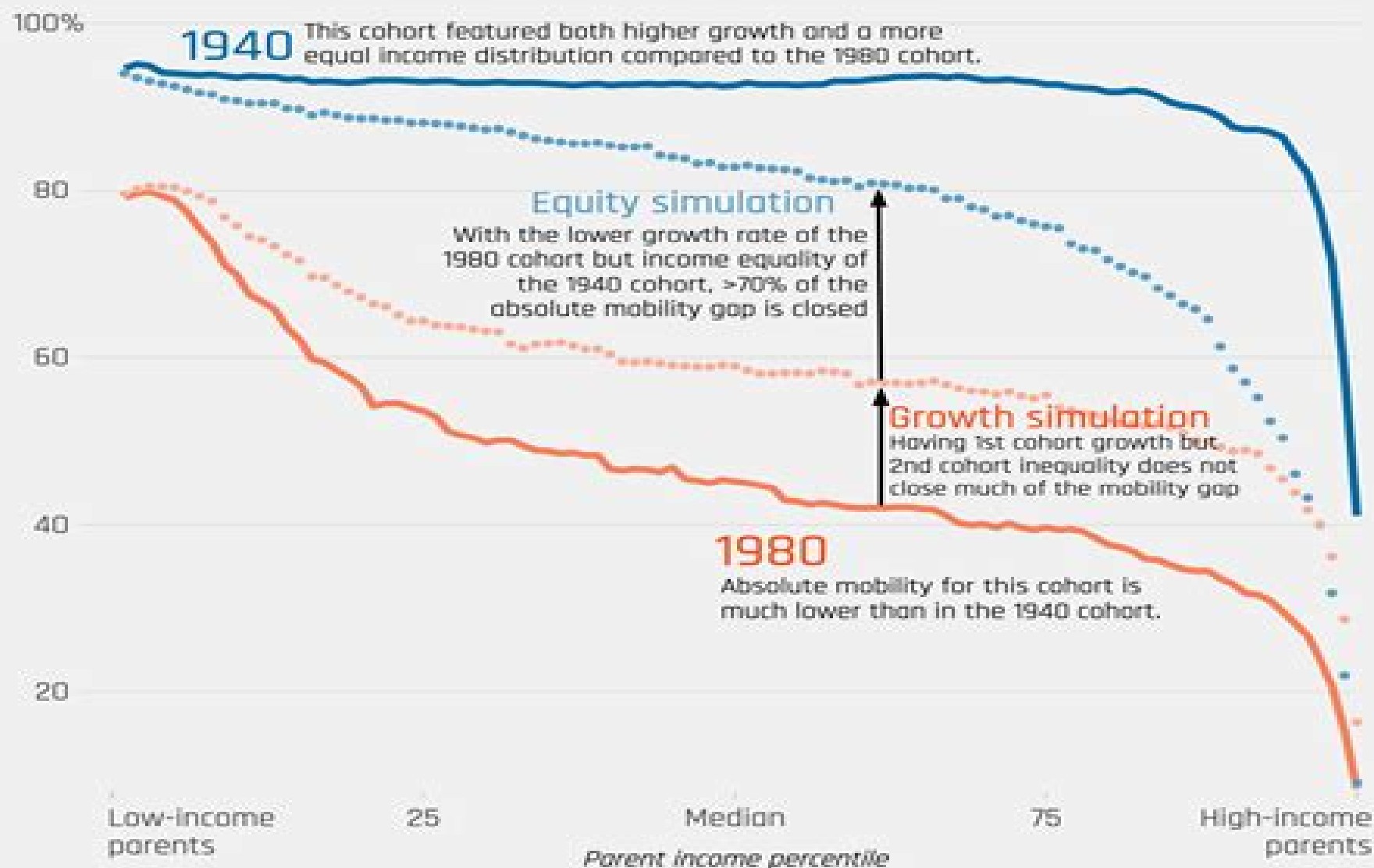


# Growth alone isn't enough: When inequality is high, mobility suffers
